

• DMLI is a four day leadership program for rising juniors. (This year only class of 2024 & 2025 invited to apply). Young men develop leadership skills while gaining exposure to different leadership styles by listening to guest speakers, participating in challenging group activities, and planning and working on Christian Service projects.

• Nominations will start **early March.** Students should ask his teacher to nominate them by sending an email to Mrs. Stockton.

• We will be accepting 25-30 students.

• The Institute will start with a half day session on **June 2nd**, immediately following the last scheduled final exam, it will continue with three full days on **June 13th**, **14th and 15th**. June 14th will be an overnight at Calleva in Poolesville, MD.

• The cost is \$100. Scholarships are available.
