



DeMatha Catholic High School Financial Information



Tuition:

Tuition for the 2026-2027 academic year is \$25,350.

Tuition Refund Plan:

Approximately 95% of DeMatha Catholic High School's annual operating budget is funded through tuition. Therefore, it is important that parents and guardians meet their financial obligations to the school so that the school can meet its financial obligations to the faculty and staff, as well as meet the costs of operating the school's buildings and programs. Without tuition payments, DeMatha Catholic High School will not be able to continue to educate young men.

Since DeMatha relies on tuition dollars, all tuition and any additional fees paid are non-refundable unless the student is withdrawn for the 2026-2027 school year by written notice received on or before August 15, 2026. Unless the student is withdrawn by written notice received on or before August 15, 2026, tuition and fees are due for the entire 2026-2027 school year. Notice of student's withdrawal must be in writing, sent by certified mail, return receipt requested, and received by the Registrar on or before August 15, 2026. **Please note that the Enrollment Fee and Tuition Deposit described below are non-refundable regardless of withdrawal date.**

With this in mind, **DeMatha requires all students to be covered by a Tuition Refund Plan (TRP) if their tuition is not paid in full by July 2026.** This plan is optional for those families that pay their tuition in full by July 2026, but it is strongly recommended. The annual cost of the TRP is \$456 for the 2026-2027 academic year, and will be included on your annual tuition bill. The TRP is designed to protect your annual financial obligation under the Tuition Agreement. This program insures a percentage of the full tuition (prepaid and due) in the event of separation from DeMatha according to terms of the policy. Enrollment Fee and Tuition Deposit

A **non-refundable** enrollment fee of \$500 and a **non-refundable** Tuition Deposit of \$300 are charged for all new students and are due at the time of enrollment.

DPO Fee:

All families must pay \$40 fee to the DeMatha Parents Organization each year. This fee will be included on your annual tuition bill. This fee is charged in lieu of fundraising by the DPO.

Tech and Text Fee:

All families must pay a \$150 Tech and Text Fee each year. This fee will be included on your tuition bill. This fee is charged to provide for the expansion and maintenance of technology resources, the acquisition of physical and digital texts, and any corresponding licenses. This fee ensures DeMatha can continue to provide textbooks to our students, saving our families over \$1,000 per year.

Graduation Fee:

Students registering for their senior year must pay an additional \$325 graduation fee. This will be included on your tuition bill. This fee covers the costs of the senior retreat, caps and gowns, diplomas, programs, tickets, rental of the Shrine, flowers, medals, awards, etc.

Tuition Payment Plans:

Tuition Payment Plans: All payment plans must be set-up through FACTS. Families must login and register their student for the upcoming school year. All tuition payment plans and incidental fee billings will be set-up for automatic withdrawal/charge. This will require the billing owner to set up a FACTS account and select a financial account (banking institution or credit card fees may apply) to assign to the FACTS account for the school year. Withdrawals are attempted three times before they must be paid directly to the school. For the first return/failed attempt, FACTS will charge a return fee of \$15.

Option 1:

Tuition is paid in full to DeMatha in July on either the 5th or the 20th of the month.

Option 2:

Tuition is paid in 2 installments. The first payment amount of half of the tuition bill is due in July. The second payment for the remaining balance is due in January. Dates selected may be the 5th or the 20th of the month.

Option 3:

Tuition is paid in 4 installments in July, October, January, and April. Dates selected may be the 5th or the 20th of the month.

Option 4:

Tuition is paid in 10 installments beginning in July and ending in April. Dates selected may be the 5th or the 20th of the month.

Option 5:

Tuition is paid in 20 installments beginning in July and ending in April. Payments are collected automatically twice each month on the 5th and the 20th of each month.

Please note: The Tuition Refund Insurance fee, Parents' Organization Fee, and Tech/Textbook Fee will be scheduled for automatic payment on June 15th. If you need to make adjustments, please contact the Business Office at mlucian@dematha.org
